Dear Residents

Thank you for your contributions to the JRRA Road Fund in 2023. Your contributions enabled us to do more pothole repairs on the flat section of the road and lay concrete on the adjoining sloping section.

Also, together with very generous donations from Joe & Lisa McDonald, Nick & Kate Green-Banks, and James & Laura Green, we much appreciate Joe obtaining the Ready Mixed Concrete which he and his team laid further down the road with no labour costs to JRRA.

Those of us who are now unable to take on the task of helping with all these repairs are extremely grateful to our fitter residents who have helped with all road repairs over the past few years, namely Joe, Nick, James, Jeff, Matt, Charlie, Ed, and Albert. However, offers of help from younger and fitter residents is always welcome.

As you are aware, there are several places along the flat section where potholes need repairing using Postcrete and we hope to start these repairs on the morning of **Saturday, 6th April**. Please contact the Committee on the above e-mail if you are able to help.

It was agreed at our Committee meeting on 20th March, that to cover the cost of 55 bags of Postcrete needed for these repairs, our annual subscriptions this year will increase to £78 per household. It is hoped that everyone will feel able to contribute to our road repair fund and help keep repairs to our vehicles at a minimum. If each household contributes this would enable us to keep the road safe and usable for residents, visitors, deliveries, Postmen, Recycling vehicles, ambulances, carers, and all services etc. The better and longer lasting our repairs can be we may eventually get to a stage where repairs are not needed on an annual basis. The success of these repairs will, of course, depend on everyone driving at a considerate and safe speed of 5mph please.

We would be grateful if you are able to make payment, or commence monthly instalments, **by the end of April please**.
