In particular, whether additional signage should be displayed.</i></p> <p><i>It was agreed that there are many roads in Tatsfield which are affected by this. It was suggested that businesses should be contacted to see what can be done from their end.</i></p> <p><i>1835/0219 Althea Davies agreed to contact companies to ascertain if anything could be done and draw up a list of affected roads. To follow up at the March main meeting."</i></p> <p>b. Potholes – Some of the potholes have been kindly filled by a mystery person! Please contact the Committee on above e-mail if you are the mystery filler! However, with the advent of rain these repairs are, unfortunately, deteriorating. As agreed at our February meeting, Groundworker Lee will supply and fill the potholes with 2 tons of tarmac when the weather is drier.
